8 **LONG TITLE**

9 **Committee Note:**

10 The Business and Labor Interim Committee recommended this bill.

11 **General Description:**

12 This bill modifies a provision that would repeal a section in the Insurance Code that
13 authorizes the state insurance commissioner to coordinate insurance related agreements
14 with other states and entities.

15 **Highlighted Provisions:**

16 This bill:

17 ▶ modifies the repeal date of Section 31A-2-217 in the Insurance Code, which
18 authorizes the insurance commissioner, by rule, to enter into agreements with other
19 states, governmental regulatory agencies, or the National Association of Insurance
20 Commissioners; and

21 ▶ extends the automatic repeal date from July 1, 2013, to July 1, 2023.
