LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill prohibits an individual from receiving a summons for trial or grand jury service more than once in a two-year time period.

78B-1-110, as renumbered and amended by Laws of Utah 2008, Chapter 3

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **78B-1-110** is amended to read:

78B-1-110. Limitations on jury service.

In any two-year period, [~~a person~~] an individual may not be [~~required~~]:

(1) required to serve on more than one grand jury;



- 28 (2) required to serve as both a grand and trial juror; or
29 (3) [~~to attend court~~] summoned more than once for prospective jury service as a trial
30 juror [~~more than one court day, except if necessary to complete service in a particular case~~].
