LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill appropriates funds for the support and operation of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ provides appropriations for the use and support of certain state agencies;
- ▶ provides appropriations for other purposes as described;
- ▶ approves employment levels for internal service funds.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates \$276,127,600 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2014, including:

- ▶ \$56,622,100 from the General Fund;
- ▶ \$219,505,500 from various sources as detailed in this bill.

This bill appropriates \$60,587,400 in business-like activities for fiscal year 2014.

This bill appropriates \$5,711,100 in restricted fund and account transfers for fiscal year 2014, including:

- ▶ \$3,171,100 from the General Fund;
- ▶ \$2,540,000 from various sources as detailed in this bill.

This bill appropriates \$207,000 in transfers to unrestricted funds for fiscal year 2014.

Other Special Clauses:

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

34 Section 1. **FY 2014 Appropriations.** The following sums of money are appropriated for the
