This bill appropriates \$276,127,600 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2014,
including:
► \$56,622,100 from the General Fund;
► \$219,505,500 from various sources as detailed in this bill.
This bill appropriates \$60,587,400 in business-like activities for fiscal year 2014.
This bill appropriates \$5,711,100 in restricted fund and account transfers for fiscal year 2014,
including:
► \$3,171,100 from the General Fund;
► \$2,540,000 from various sources as detailed in this bill.
This bill appropriates \$207,000 in transfers to unrestricted funds for fiscal year 2014.
Other Special Clauses:
This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.
