LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill appropriates money to increase the number of students admitted to the University of Utah School of Medicine.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ authorizes the University of Utah School of Medicine to increase the number of students admitted by 40 students for a total of 122 students annually; and
- ▶ ~~restricts the 40 additional admissions to students who demonstrate a strong connection to;~~ requires that no fewer than 80% of all students admitted annually to the University of Utah School of Medicine shall:
 - meet the qualifications of resident student for the purposes of tuition; or
 - have graduated from a high school, college, or university located in Utah.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates:

- ▶ to the University of Utah School of Medicine, as an ongoing appropriation for fiscal year 2013-14:
 - from the Education Fund, \$10,000,000.

Other Special Clauses:

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.

53B-17-901, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53B-17-901** is enacted to read:

Part 9. School of Medicine

53B-17-901. Admissions -- Increase authorized~~{ and restricted to students who demonstrate strong connection to Utah}~~.

(1) Beginning with the 2013-14 school year and subject to Subsection (2), the University of Utah School of Medicine may increase the number of students admitted by 40 students for a total of 122 students admitted annually.

(2) ~~{(a) The additional 40 admissions authorized under Subsection (1) shall be restricted to students who demonstrate a strong connection to Utah.~~

~~—(b) The}~~ Beginning with the 2013-14 school year, no fewer than 80% of the students admitted annually shall:

(a) meet the qualifications of a resident student for the purpose of tuition in accordance with:

(i) Section 53B-8-102;

(ii) State Board of Regents policy on determining resident status; and

(iii) University of Utah ~~{School of Medicine Admissions Committee shall establish criteria to determine whether a student demonstrates a strong connection to}~~ policy on determining resident status;

(b) have graduated from a public or private college or university located in Utah; or

(c) have graduated from a public or private high school located in Utah.

Section 2. Appropriation.

Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, the following sums of money are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated. These sums of money are in addition to any amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2014.
