	WHEREAS, the state of Utah supports efforts to eradicate this disease;
	WHEREAS, the State of Utah recognizes that the Huntsman Cancer Institute is a source
	of major technologic and economic activity in the state of Utah;
	WHEREAS, the Huntsman Cancer Institute at the University of Utah is owned by the
	state of Utah and includes more than 2,000 employees across its research and clinical missions
	in Utah;
	WHEREAS, the Huntsman Cancer Institute effectively leverages state support, and
]	researchers secure an average of \$70,000,000 in annual cancer research funding to support
•	cancer investigations;
	WHEREAS, the Huntsman Cancer Institute's Children's and Families' Cancer Research
	Facility expansion is estimated to cost \$100,000,000, of which \$80,000,000 in funding shall be
	provided by private sources;
	WHEREAS, the Huntsman Cancer Institute critically needs a research expansion
	estimated to provide 220,000 square feet of new research space;
	WHEREAS, the building will be wholly owned by the state of Utah;
	WHEREAS, this expansion will add a projected 300 new employees with an average
	annual salary and benefits compensation of \$70,000; and
	WHEREAS, the Huntsman Cancer Institute plays a major role in training scientists and
	medical professionals:
