The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 61**, DIXIE STATE COLLEGE - UNIVERSITY STATUS, by Representative D. Ipson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 21:
 - 16 Money Appropriated in this Bill:
 - 17 { This bill appropriates:
 - 18 to Dixie State University Education and General, as an ongoing appropriation:
 - from the Education Fund, \$4,000,000. None
 - 20 Other Special Clauses:

- 2. Page 12, Lines 351 through 366:
 - 351 { Section 11. Appropriation.
 - 352 (1) Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act,
 - 353 <u>for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, the following sums of</u>
 - 354 <u>money are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts</u>
