Madam Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 121**, FIREARMS SAFE HARBOR, by Representative D. Pitcher, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 61 through 66:
 - 61 (1) (a) An owner cohabitant may voluntarily commit a firearm to a law enforcement
 62 agency for safekeeping if the owner cohabitant believes that another cohabitant is an
 - 62 <u>agency for safekeeping if the owner cohabitant believes that another cohabitant is ar</u> <u>immediate</u>
 - 63 <u>threat to:</u>
 - $64 \qquad \{ \underline{(a)} \} \quad \underline{(i)} \quad \underline{\text{himself or herself}};$
 - 65 $\{\underline{(b)}\}$ <u>(ii)</u> the owner cohabitant; or
 - 66 { (iii) any other person. (b) A law enforcement agency may not hold a firearm under this section if the law enforcement agency obtains the firearm in a manner other than the owner cohabitant voluntarily presenting, of his or her own free will, the firearm to the law enforcement agency at the agency's office.
- 2. Page 3, Line 88:
 - 88 <u>other cohabitant.</u>

<u>(5) Notwithstanding an ordinance or policy to the contrary adopted in</u> <u>accordance with 63G-2-701, a law enforcement agency shall destroy a record created</u> <u>under Subsection (2), Subsection 53-5c-202(4)(b)(iii), or any other record created in</u>







<u>the application of this chapter no later than five days after:</u> <u>(a) returning a firearm in accordance with Subsection (2)(d); or</u> <u>(b) appropriating, selling, or destroying the firearm in accordance with Section</u> <u>53-5c-202.</u>

- 3. Page 3, Line 89 through Page 4, Line 91:
 - 89 {(5)} (6) Unless otherwise provided, the provisions of Title 77, Chapter 24, Disposal of
 - 90 <u>Property Received by Peace Officer, do not apply to a firearm received by a law</u> enforcement
 - 91 agency in accordance with this chapter.

(7) A law enforcement agency shall adopt a policy for the safekeeping of a firearm held in accordance with this chapter.
