Vice Chair Ivory called the meeting to order at 2:07 p.m.

MOTION: Rep. Grover moved to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2013 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Noel and Rep. Powell absent for the vote.

S.B. 130 Security Personnel Licensing Act Amendments (*Sen. M. Dayton*)

Sen. Dayton introduced the bill and the proposed amendment to the committee, assisted by John Tinsley, Private Security.

MOTION: Rep. Grover moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:

- 12 ▶ modifies the Security Personnel Licensing Act by:
- 13 • adding an additional board member =
- amending board member provisions ; and
- 14 • changing the requirements for an applicant to be licensed as an armored car
- 15 company or a contract security company; and

2. Page 2, Lines 29 through 37
Senate Committee Amendments

- 30 (1) There is created the Security Services Licensing Board consisting of:

MOTION: Rep. Perry moved to adopt the amendment except as follows:

Line 36: Delete "Utah Fraternal Order of Police" and insert "largest law enforcement association based upon current Utah resident law enforcement membership".

The substitute motion to amend the bill failed with Rep. Grover voting in favor of the motion.

The original motion to amend the bill failed with Rep. Grover voting in favor of the motion.

MOTION: Rep. Perry moved to pass S.B. 130. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Noel and Rep. Powell absent for the vote.

H.B. 43 Campaign Finance Reporting by Corporations (Rep. G. Hughes)

Rep. Hughes introduced the bill to the committee, assisted by Brad Daw, citizen and former state representative. A handout was provided to committee members.

MOTION: Rep. Draxler moved to adopt 1st Substitute H.B. 43. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Noel and Rep. Powell absent for the vote.

Spoke in opposition to the bill: Allen Dickerson, Center for Competitive Politics (handout)

MOTION: Rep. Noel moved to pass H.B. 43 out favorably. The motion passed with Rep. Chavez-Houck and Rep. Ivory voting in opposition to the motion.

Vice Chair Ivory relinquished the chair to Chair Draxler.

H.B. 205 Contingency Plans for Political Subdivisions (*Rep. K. Ivory*)

Rep. Ivory introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Grover moved to pass H.B. 205 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

Vice Chair Ivory resumed the chair.

H.B. 223 Emergency Management Funding Amendments (*Rep. C. Oda*)

Rep. Oda introduced the bill to the committee, assisted by Matt Price, Utah National Guard

MOTION: Rep. Draxler moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 1, Line 26:*

26 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.

This bill coordinates with H.B. 302, Emergency Response Amendments, by providing substantive and technical corrections.

2. *Page 2, Line 33:*

33 63J-1-602.3, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2012, Chapters 71, 341, and 398

276 Section 7. Effective date.
277 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2013.

Section 8. Coordinating H.B. 223 with H.B. 302 -- Substantive and technical amendments.

If this H.B. 223 and H.B. 302, Emergency Response Amendments, both pass and become law, it is the intent of the Legislature that:

(1) Subsection 53-2-404(1) shall be amended to read:

"(1) Subject to this section and Section [~~53-2-403~~] ~~53-2a-603~~, the division [~~shall expend or commit to expend money described in Subsection 53-2-403(1)(d)(i) to fund costs to the state of emergency disaster services]~~ may expend or commit to expend money described in Subsection 53-2a-603(2)(a)(i), (ii), or (iii) to fund costs to the state of emergency disaster services if, at the discretion of the division, the expenditure is necessary in response to the disaster." ;

(2) Subsection 63J-1-602.3(2) shall be amended to read:

"(2) Appropriations made to the Division of Emergency Management from the State Disaster Recovery Restricted Account, as provided in Section 53-2a-603. "; and

(3) the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel make these changes when preparing the Utah Code database for publication.

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Perry and Rep. Powell absent for the vote.

Spoke in favor of the bill: Kris Hamlet, Division of Emergency Management

MOTION: Rep. Grover moved to pass H.B. 223. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Noel absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Perry moved to place H.B. 223 on the Consent Calendar. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Noel absent for the vote.

H.B. 125 Interstate Local Emergency Response Act (Rep. C. Oda)

Rep. Oda introduced the bill to the committee.

Spoke in favor of the bill: Mr. Coy Porter, State Fire Marshall

MOTION: Rep. Perry moved to pass H.B. 125 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rep. Grover moved to place H.B. 125 on the Consent Calendar. The motion passed unanimously.
