2, Lines 28 through 32

- 28 (a) "School" means an elementary school or a secondary school that:
29 (i) is a public or private school **located in the state** ; and
30 (ii) provides student instruction for one or more years of kindergarten through grade
 9.
31 (b) "Youth organization" means **a local Utah chapter of** :
32 ~~(a)~~ (i) the Boy Scouts of America;
