Chair Barrus called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

H.B. 100 Internet Privacy Amendments (*Rep. S. Barlow*)

Rep. Barlow introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Handy moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 3, Lines 82 through 84:*

82 (b) disciplining or discharging an employee for transferring the employer's proprietary
83 or confidential information or financial data to an employee's personal Internet account
{~~with~~} without
84 the employer's authorization;

2. *Page 4, Lines 119 through 120:*

119 (2) In an action brought under Subsection (1), if the court finds a violation of this
120 chapter, the court shall award the aggrieved person not more than \$500.

3. *Page 6, Lines 174 through 175:*

174 (2) In an action brought under Subsection (1), if the court finds a violation of this
175 chapter, the court shall award the aggrieved person not more than \$500.

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson and Rep. Webb absent for the vote.
