Chair Bramble called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. and announced that, at the request of the sponsor, **S.B. 64** will not be heard today.

### Approval of Minutes

**MOTION:** Sen. Henderson moved to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2013 meeting.  
The motion passed unanimously.

Chair Bramble relinquished the Committee Chair to Sen. Henderson.

### **S.B. 168 Certified Public Accountant Licensing Amendments** (*Bramble*)

Sen. Bramble introduced and explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Bramble moved to transmit **S.B. 168** favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

Chair Bramble resumed the Committee Chair.

### **S.B. 55 Insurance Coverage for Autism Spectrum Disorder** (*B. Shizawa*)

Sen Shizawa introduced and explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Weiler moved to delete in title and body **S.B. 55** and replace it with **1stSub. S.B. 55**. The motion passed unanimously.

Sen. Shizawa further explained the bill and answered questions from the Committee, assisted by Lori Unumb, National Autism Speaks and Paul Carbone, Pediatrician, University of Utah.

803 applying for the master full-service restaurant license:  
804 (i) owns each of the full-service restaurants; {and}  
805 (ii) except for the fee requirements, establishes to the satisfaction of the commission  
806 that each location of a full-service restaurant under the master full-service restaurant  
license  
807 separately meets the requirements of this part { } ; and  
(iii) the master full-service restaurant license includes at least five full-service  
restaurant locations.

866 (1) (a) The commission may issue a master limited-service restaurant license that  
867 authorizes a person to store, sell, offer for sale, furnish, or allow the consumption of an  
868 alcoholic product on premises at multiple locations as limited-service restaurants if the  
person  
869 applying for the master limited-service restaurant license:  
870 (i) owns each of the limited-service restaurants; {and}  
871 (ii) except for the fee requirements, establishes to the satisfaction of the commission  
872 that each location of a limited-service restaurant under the master limited-service  
restaurant  
873 license separately meets the requirements of this part { } ; and  
(iii) the master limited-service restaurant includes at least five limited-service  
restaurant locations.
