MOTION: Sen Dayton moved to approve minutes of the February 19, 2013 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 76 Outdoor Advertising Technology Amendments *(P. Knudson)*

S.B. 222 Transportation Amendments *(W. Harper)*

MOTION: Sen. Harper introduced the bill and moved to adopt the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:*

- 12 ▶ provides that beginning on the date that the Motor Vehicle Division has
 implemented the Motor Vehicle Division's GenTax system, the
 requirement to pass a safety inspection annually or obtain a valid
13 annual federal inspection only applies to a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle
14 weight rating of 10,001 pounds or more if the motor vehicle is a commercial
15 vehicle; and

2. *Page 3, Lines 60 through 62:*

- 60 (b) ~~{A}~~ [motor vehicle] Beginning on the date that the Motor Vehicle
 Division has implemented the Motor Vehicle Division's GenTax system, a
 commercial vehicle as defined in Section 41-1a-102 with a gross
61 vehicle weight rating of 10,001 pounds or more is required to pass a safety inspection
 annually
62 or comply with Subsection (1)(b)(iv)(B).

The motion passed unanimously.

Sen. Harper further explained the bill.
