

# H.B. 64

## FELON'S RIGHT TO HOLD OFFICE

Representative **Carol Spackman Moss** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 8 through 14:*

8 General Description:

9 This bill prohibits ~~{a felon}~~ an individual convicted of certain ~~{crimes}~~ sexual  
10 offenses from holding certain offices.

10 Highlighted Provisions:

11 This bill:

12 ▶ prohibits ~~{a felon}~~ an individual who is convicted of ~~{a sexual offense}~~ certain  
13 sexual offenses from holding the office of

13 State Board of Education member or local school board member; and

14 ▶ makes conforming and technical changes.

2. *Page 2, Lines 44 through 45:*

44 (4) ~~{A convicted felon who is a sex offender, as defined in Section 77-41-102}~~ An individual  
45 who has been convicted of a grievous sexual offense, as defined in Section 76-1-601 . may not  
45 hold the office of State Board of Education member or local school board member.
