MOTOR VEHICLE EVENT DATA RECORDERS

Senator **Mark B. Madsen** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 59 through 67:*

- 59 (1) (a) "Event data" means records of one or more of the following categories of
60 information regarding a motor vehicle that are captured by an event data recorder:
61 (i) whether the vehicle's air bag deployed;
62 (ii) vehicle speed;
63 { ~~(iii) vehicle direction;~~
64 ~~— (iv) vehicle location;~~ }
65 { ~~(v)~~ } (iii) vehicle steering performance;
66 { ~~(vi)~~ } (iv) vehicle brake performance or use; or
67 { ~~(vii)~~ } (v) vehicle seatbelt status or use.

2. *Page 3, Lines 69 through 72:*

- 69 (2) "Event data recorder" { ~~means a device or function in a vehicle that records the~~
70 ~~vehicle's dynamic, time-series data during the time period just prior to a crash event, including~~
71 ~~vehicle speed versus time, or during a crash event, including delta-V versus time, intended for~~
72 ~~retrieval after the crash event.~~ } has the same meaning as defined in 49 C.F.R. Sec. 563.5.
