S.B. 92 TETHERING OF ANIMALS

Senator **Gene Davis** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 13:
 - prohibits the { tethering } restraining of a dog by a tether for more than 10 hours in a 24-hour period and applies this offense only in a first or second class county;
 - prohibits { tethering } use of a tether that causes harm to the dog and applies this offense only in a first or second class county; and
- 2. Page 4, Line 94:
 - 94 (f) {uses} in counties of the first or second class, restrains a dog by use of a tether that is not:
- 3. Page 4, Line 100:
 - 100 (g) <u>in counties of the first or second class</u>, {<u>tethers</u>} <u>restrains</u> <u>a dog</u> <u>by means of a</u>

 <u>tether</u> in any manner that could reasonably be expected to:
- 4. Page 4, Line 106:
 - 106 (h) {<u>tethers</u>} in counties of the first or second class, restrains a dog by use of a tether for longer than 10 hours within a 24-hour period.
