1. *Page 1, Lines 15a through 15f*

Senate Committee Amendments

2-7-2013:

- 15a ▶ provides that **until July 1, 2014,** a state or local law enforcement officer may not issue a citation
to a
- 15b person 19 years of age or older who has been detained **{for the first time}** for a safety belt
15c violation that is enforced as a primary offense but shall issue the person a warning informing
15d the person that wearing a safety belt while operating or a passenger in a motor vehicle is
15e enforced as a primary offense on a highway with a posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour or
15f more; and ←§

2. *Page 2, Lines 56a through 56e*

a. Senate Committee Amendments

b. 2-7-2013:

- 56a §→ (c) **{-A}** **Until July 1, 2014, a** state or local law enforcement officer may not issue a citation
to a person 19
- 56b years of age or older who has been detained **{for the first time}** for a violation of Subsection
56c (1)(a)(i) or (2) that is enforced as a primary offense but shall issue the person a warning
56d informing the person that wearing a safety belt in a motor vehicle is enforced as a primary
56e offense on a highway with a posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour or more. ←§
