

DEEP CREEK CASE APPROPRIATION

2013 FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill supplements or reduces appropriations previously provided for the use and operation of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ provides appropriations for the settlement of Deep Creek Ranch LLC v. Utah State Armory Board; and
- ▶ provides appropriations for the bills and resolutions with fiscal impact passed in the 2013 First Special Session.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates for fiscal year 2014:

- ▶ \$2,995,000 from the General Fund Budget Reserve Account.

Other Special Clauses:

This bill takes effect immediately.

Utah Code Sections Affected:

ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2014.
