**General Description:**

This bill requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to hold a meeting on daylight saving time.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ defines "daylight saving time";
- ▶ requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to hold a meeting on daylight saving time; and
- ▶ requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to report on the meeting

to the Government Operations Interim Committee ~~H→~~ **and the Economic Development and Workforce Services Interim Committee ←H** .
