126	(8) A standards review committee shall submit, to the board, comments and

130	(10) (a) Nothing in this section prohibits the board from amending or adding individual
131	core curriculum standards as the need arises in the board's ongoing responsibilities.
132	(b) If the board makes changes as described in Subsection (10)(a), the board shall
