LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to hold a meeting on daylight saving time.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ defines "daylight saving time";
- ▶ requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to hold a meeting on daylight saving time; and
- ▶ requires the Governor's Office of Economic Development to report on the meeting to the Government Operations Interim Committee and the Economic Development and Workforce Services Interim Committee.

45 time;

46 (b) invite parents, senior citizens, and representatives from the agricultural, public
47 education, recreation, and business communities to attend the meeting;

48 (c) compile comments and recommendations made at the meeting;

49 (d) publish a summary of the meeting; and

50 (e) report on the summary to the Government Operations Interim Committee and the
51 Economic Development and Workforce Services Interim Committee no later than November 1,
