Section 1. Section 17-22-31 is enacted to read:
<u>17-22-31.</u> Sheriff Primary law enforcement authority.
The sheriff is the primary law enforcement authority of state law on federal land except
as otherwise assigned by law to the authority of a state or municipal law enforcement agency.
