	(1) A school nurse may assess a child who is suspected of sustaining a concussion or a
	traumatic head injury during school hours on school property regardless of whether the nurse
	has received specialized training in the evaluation and management of a concussion.
	(2) A school nurse who does not meet the requirements of Subsections
	26-53-301(1)(b)(i) and (1)(b)(ii)(A), but who assesses a child who is suspected of sustaining a

- 31 (a) shall refer the child to a qualified health care provider who is trained in the
