General Description:

This bill modifies the Motor Vehicles code related to license plates.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- requires that a license plate be displayed in a manner to be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.

AMENDS:

41-1a-403, as renumbered and amended by Laws of Utah 1992, Chapter 1

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **41-1a-403** is amended to read:

41-1a-403. Plates to be legible from 100 feet.

License plates and the required letters and numerals on them, except the decals and the



26 slogan, shall be of sufficient size and displayed in a manner to be plainly readable from a
27 distance of 100 feet during daylight.
