LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the Department of Natural Resources provisions by repealing certain natural resources related accounts.

- ▶ repeals the Natural Resources Conservation Easement Account;
- ▶ repeals the Wetlands Protection Account; and
- ▶ makes conforming changes.
