ARTICLE VII, SECTION 14 ARTICLE VII, SECTION 15

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, two-thirds of all members elected to each of the two houses voting in favor thereof:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 14, to read:

Article VII, Section 14. [Duties of Lieutenant Governor.]

(1) The Lieutenant Governor shall:

[(1)] (a) serve on all boards and commissions in lieu of the Governor whenever so designated by the Governor;

[(2)] (b) perform such duties as may be delegated by the Governor; and

[(3)] (c) perform other duties as may be provided by statute.

(2) The Lieutenant Governor may appoint legal counsel to advise the Lieutenant Governor when a conflict of interest prevents the Attorney General from providing legal advice, except that the appointed legal counsel may not represent the Lieutenant Governor in judicial proceedings.

Section 2. It is proposed to amend Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 15, to read:

Article VII, Section 15. [Duties of State Auditor and State Treasurer.]

(1) The State Auditor shall perform financial post audits of public accounts except as otherwise provided by this Constitution.

(2) The State Treasurer shall be the custodian of public moneys.

(3) Each shall perform other duties as provided by statute.

(4) The State Auditor may appoint legal counsel to advise the State Auditor {, and the} when a conflict of interest prevents the Attorney General from providing legal advice, except that the appointed legal counsel may not represent the State Auditor in judicial proceedings.

(5) The State Treasurer may appoint legal counsel to advise the State Treasurer when a conflict of interest prevents the Attorney General from providing legal advice, except that the appointed legal counsel may not represent the State Treasurer in judicial proceedings.

Section 4. Contingent effective date.

If the amendment proposed by this joint resolution is approved by a majority of those voting on it at the next regular general election, the amendment shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
