LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill provides an exemption for an active duty servicemember when renewing a concealed firearm permit.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▶ exempts an active duty servicemember from the Utah concealed firearm permit reciprocity requirement if stationed out of state.

ENACTS:

53-5-712, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53-5-712** is enacted to read:

53-5-712. Armed Forces -- Permit requirements -- Exemptions.

An active duty servicemember of the United States Armed Forces who possesses a Utah concealed firearm permit is exempt from the requirement in Subsection **53-5-704(4)(a)** when
