7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill supplements or reduces appropriations previously provided for the use and operation
10 of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014; and
11 appropriates funds for the support and operation of state government for the fiscal year beginning
12 July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015.

13 **Highlighted Provisions:**

14 This bill:

- 15 ▶ provides appropriations for the use and support of certain state agencies; and
- 16 ▶ provides appropriations for other purposes as described.

17 **Money Appropriated in this Bill:**

18 This bill appropriates (\$25,541,000) in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2014,
19 including:

- 20 ▶ (\$22,454,000) from the General Fund;
- 21 ▶ (\$3,087,000) from various sources as detailed in this bill.

22 This bill appropriates \$490,000 in expendable funds and accounts for fiscal year 2014, all of
23 which is from the General Fund.

24 This bill appropriates \$772,997,200 in operating and capital budgets for fiscal year 2015,
25 including:

- 26 ▶ \$563,799,800 from the General Fund;
- 27 ▶ \$49,000 from the Education Fund;
- 28 ▶ \$209,148,400 from various sources as detailed in this bill.

29 This bill appropriates \$26,694,000 in business-like activities for fiscal year 2015.

30 This bill appropriates \$216,000 in restricted fund and account transfers for fiscal year 2015,
31 all of which is from the General Fund.

32 **Other Special Clauses:**

33 Section 1 of this bill takes effect immediately. Section 2 of this bill takes effect on July 1,
34 2014.

38 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

39 Section 1. **FY 2014 Appropriations.** Under the terms and conditions of Utah Code Title
 40 63J Chapter 1, the following sums of money are appropriated from resources not otherwise
 41 appropriated, or reduced from amounts previously appropriated, out of the funds or fund accounts
 42 indicated for the use and support of the government of the State of Utah for the fiscal year beginning
 43 July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
 44 fiscal year 2014.

45 Subsection 1(a). **Operating and Capital Budgets.** Under the terms and conditions of
 46 Utah Code Title 63J, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or
 47 fund accounts indicated for the use and support of the government of the State of Utah.

 459 and other charges. Where applicable, the Legislature authorizes the State Division of Finance to
 460 transfer amounts among funds and accounts as indicated.

477 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, Section 1 of this bill
 478 takes effect upon approval by the Governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of

479 Utah Constitution Article VII, Section 8 without the Governor's signature, or in the case of a veto,
