

26	53A-3-413. Use of public school buildings and grounds as civic centers.
27	(1) As used in this section, "civic center" means a public school building or ground that
28	is established and maintained as a limited public forum to district residents for supervised
29	recreational activities and meetings.
30	(2) Except as provided in Subsection (3), all public school buildings and grounds shall
31	be civic centers.
32	(3) [Use] The use of school property for a civic center [purposes] purpose:
33	(a) may not interfere with a school function or purpose[-]; and
34	(b) is considered a permit for governmental immunity purposes for a governmental
35	entity under Subsection 63G-7-301(5)(c).
