27 Section 1. Section **20A-6-103** is amended to read:

29 Notwithstanding any [~~other provisions~~] provision of this title[~~, any~~] to the contrary, a
30 county may[~~, if selected by the Department of Defense, participate in the Federal Voting~~
31 ~~Assistance Program pilot project to~~] allow a covered voter, as defined in Section 20A-16-102,
32 or a voter with a disability, as that term is used in Public Law 107-252, the Help America Vote
33 Act of 2002, to register to vote, and [~~cast their votes~~] vote electronically.
