## Madam Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 41**, CLEAN FUEL SCHOOL BUSES AND INFRASTRUCTURE, by Representative S. Handy, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 16:
  - allows the State Board of Education to award a grant to a school district or charter
  - 14 school to:
  - replace a school bus manufactured before 2002 with a new school bus that uses
  - 16 { CNG, propane, } <u>alternative fuel</u> or clean diesel fuel;
- 2. Page 2, Line 46:
  - 46 (a) "Alternative fuel" means CNG (or propane propane blended biodiesel, or electricity .
- *3. Page 2, Lines 51 through 53:* 
  - 51 (2) The board may award a grant to a school district or charter school to:
  - 52 (a) replace a school bus manufactured before 2002 with a new school bus that uses
  - 53 { CNG, propane, } alternative fuel or clean diesel fuel;







- 1. Page 3, Line 61:
  - 61 (b) specifying criteria for selecting a grant recipient consistent with the requirements of Subsection (4) :
- 2. Page 3, Line 63:
  - 63 purchased with grant money has replaced a school bus manufactured before 2002; {-and-}
- 3. *Page 3, Lines 65 through 66:* 
  - 65 than or equal to the amount of a grant received under this section {:}

    (e) requiring a grant recipient to ensure that a replaced school bus is made permanently inoperable; and
    - (f) requiring a grant recipient to expend the grant within two years of receiving the grant.
    - <u>(4) The board shall specify criteria for selecting a grant recipient in</u> <u>consultation with the Division of Air Quality, including the following criteria:</u>
      - (a) fuel savings;
    - (b) the emissions reduction or environmental improvement over the remaining useful life of a school bus that is taken out of operation;
      - (c) the amount of matching funds provided;
      - (d) the number and capacity of alternative fuel fueling stations installed; and
    - (e) a commitment to use fuel savings to purchase school buses that use alternative fuel or clean diesel fuel until all school buses manufactured before 2002 are replaced.
  - 66 {-(4)} (5) The board shall appoint a committee that includes representatives of school
- 4. Page 3, Line 70:
  - 70 { (5) } (6) Through the state superintendent of public instruction, the board shall facilitate
