NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 7, 2014

Madam Speaker:

The Transportation Committee has returned **H.B. 122**, TRAFFIC CODE MODIFICATIONS, by Representative K. Christofferson, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 17 through 21:
 - provides that in free-flowing traffic on a highway having more than one lane in the
 - same direction, if a vehicle is following directly behind an operator's vehicle in the
 - 19 left general purpose lane { at a distance so that less than three seconds elapse before
 - **20** reaching the location of the operator's vehicle, or if the operator's vehicle is passed
 - 21 by two or more vehicles in the next lane right, the operator:
- 2. Page 12, Line 365 through Page 13, Line 369:
 - 365 [(2) On] (3) In free-flowing traffic on a highway having more than one lane in the
 - same direction, [the operator of a vehicle traveling in the left general purpose lane] if a vehicle
 - 367 <u>is following directly behind an operator's vehicle in the left general purpose lane</u> { at a distance
 - 368 <u>so that less than three seconds elapse before reaching the location of the operator's</u>
