Madam Speaker:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 137**, HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL TRUTH IN ADVERTISING, by Senator T. Weiler, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. Page 3, Lines 70 through 83

Senate 3rd Reading Amendments

2-19-2014:

- 70 (4) A health care provider is not required to wear identification:
- 71 (a) if wearing identification would jeopardize the health care provider's safety; $\hat{S} \rightarrow [and]$
- 71a <u>or</u> **←**Ŝ
- 72 (b) (i) in an office in which:
- 73 (A) the license type and names of all health care providers working in the office are
- 74 <u>displayed on the office door;</u> {<u>and</u>} <u>or</u>
- 75 (B) each health care provider working in the office has the health care provider's
- 76 license posted prominently in the office and readily visible to a patient; and
- 77 (ii) if the office is an office:
- 78 (A) of a solo health care provider; $\hat{S} \rightarrow \underline{or} \leftarrow \hat{S}$
- 79 (B) of a single type of health care provider $\hat{S} \rightarrow [; \text{or}]$. $\leftarrow \hat{S}$
- 80 $\hat{S} \rightarrow [\underline{(C)}]$ with no more than two types of health care providers in which each patient is seen
- 81 <u>by only one health care provider in the office, a patient does not receive services from</u> <u>another</u>







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- 82 <u>health care provider in the office, and the health care providers do not provide cross</u> <u>coverage</u>
- 83 <u>of services for the patients of other health care providers in the office.</u>] $\leftarrow \hat{S}$
