## Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on S.B. 172, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AMENDMENTS, by Senator W. Harper, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 18:
  - and infrastructure to capital improvements;
    - <u>▶ prohibits the Legislature from funding the programming, design, and construction of a new building or facility in phases over more than one year unless the Legislature has approved each phase of the funding for the construction of the new building or facility by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house;</u>
- 2. Page 7, Lines 199 through 200:
  - be reduced to 0.9% of the replacement cost of state facilities.
    - (8) It is the policy of the Legislature that a new building or facility be approved and funded for construction in a single budget action, therefore the Legislature may not fund the programming, design, and construction of a new building or facility in phases over more than one year unless the Legislature has approved each phase of the funding for the construction of the new building or facility by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house.
