Mr. President:

The Revenue and Taxation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 19**, APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS OF THE STATE TAX COMMISSION, by Senator H. Stephenson, with the following amendments:

0. Page 3, Lines 67 through 78:

- 67 (1) [~~Members~~] {~~A~~} **Each** member of the commission [~~shall have~~]:  
68 (a) shall have significant tax experience that is relevant to holding office as a  
69 commissioner;  
70 (b) shall have knowledge of tax administration **or tax compliance** ; [~~and~~]  
71 (c) shall have executive and administrative experience[-]; and  
72 (d) except for one member who has substantial knowledge and expertise in the theory  
73 and practice of ad valorem taxation as described in Subsection (2)(a), shall have  
74 substantial  
74 knowledge and experience in one or more of the following:  
75 (i) the theory and practice of excise taxation;  
76 (ii) the theory and practice of income taxation;  
77 (iii) the theory and practice of sales and use taxation; and  
78 (iv) the theory and practice of corporate taxation.
