Vice Chair Pitcher called the meeting to order at 8:11 a.m.

MOTION: Rep. Anderegg moved to approve the minutes of the February 24, 2014 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson, Rep. Layton, and Rep. Wilson absent for the vote.

H.B. 376 Alcohol Revisions (*Rep. R. Wilcox*)

Rep. Wilcox explained the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Froerer moved to pass out favorably H.B. 376. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson, Rep. Layton, and Rep. Wilson absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Anderegg moved to place H.B. 376 on the Consent Calendar. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson, Rep. Layton, and Rep. Wilson absent for the vote.

H.B. 352 **Manufacturing Licensee Provisions** (*Rep. G. Froerer*)

MOTION: Rep. Froerer moved to replace H.B. 352 with 1st Substitute H.B. 352. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Anderson, Rep. Layton, and Rep. Wilson absent for the vote.

H.B. 129 **Surplus Lines Insurance Amendments** (*Rep. C. Oda*)

H.B. 12 **Consumer Credit Protection Amendments** (*Rep. P. Ray*)

H.B. 277 **Music Therapist Licensure Amendments** (*Rep. R. Edwards*)

Rep. Edwards explained the bill to the committee assisted by Maureen Hearn, Director of Music Therapy, Utah State University.
