H.B. 243 Amendments to the Fund of Funds (*Rep. J. Bird*)

MOTION: Rep. Stanard moved to replace H.B. 243 with 2nd Substitute H.B. 243. The motion passed with Rep. Anderegg voting in opposition and Rep. Cox, Rep. Layton, and Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.
