  - 61 (k) an individual representing special districts, appointed by the governor; and [(k)] (l) two individuals who are members of the public and who have knowledge,
  - 62 expertise, or experience in matters relating to the board's duties under Subsection (10),
  - 63 appointed by the board members identified in Subsections (2)(a) through  $\{-(j)\}$  <u>(k)</u>.
- 3. Page 6, Lines 163 through 164:
  - 163 (11) The department shall, in consultation with the board and as funding allows , modify the information
  - 164 website described in Subsection (10) to:
