**H.B. 76 Insurance Related Revisions (*Rep. J. Bird*)**

**MOTION:** Rep. Greenwood moved to send the bill back to the Rules Committee with a recommendation that it be reassigned to the Business and Labor Standing Committee. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ray absent for the vote.

**H.B. 48 Reports on Alternative Sentencing (*Rep. S. Duckworth*)**

Rep. Duckworth explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Layton moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Greenwood absent for the vote.

**H.B. 75 Restoration of Civil Rights for Nonviolent Felons (*Rep. C. Oda*)**

**H.B. 50      Involuntary Feeding and Hydration of Inmates Amendments (Rep. R. Greenwood)**
