Chair Anderson called the meeting to order at 8:08 a.m.

**MOTION:** Rep. Peterson moved to approve the minutes of the February 26, 2014 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow, Rep. Fisher, Rep. Lifferth, Rep. Pitcher, and Rep. Sanpei absent for the vote.

**H.B. 152 Highway Sponsorship Program Act (Rep. J. Knotwell)**

Rep. Knotwell explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Knotwell moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 3, Lines 62 through 64:

- 62 (a) traveler information; **and**  
63 (b) rest areas {~~;~~**and**  
64 ~~(c) incident management services~~ }

2. Page 4, Lines 90 through 106:

- 90 (5) {~~(a)~~} In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act.

91 the department shall make and enforce rules governing:
