(4) (a) This section does not apply to an Internet service provider, as defined in Section 76-10-1230, if:
(i) the distribution of an intimate image by the Internet service provider occurs only incidentally through the Internet service provider's function of:

(A) transmitting or routing data from one person to another person; or

(B) providing a connection between one person and another person;

(ii) the Internet service provider does not intentionally aid or abet in the distribution of an intimate image; and

(iii) the Internet service provider does not knowingly receive funds from or through a person who distributes an intimate image in exchange for permitting the person to distribute an intimate image.

(b) This section does not apply to a hosting company, as defined in Section 76-10-1230, if:

(i) the distribution of an intimate image by the hosting company occurs only incidentally through

the hosting company's function of providing data storage space or data caching to a person;

(ii) the hosting company does not intentionally engage, aid, or abet in the distribution of an intimate image; and

(iii) the hosting company does not knowingly receive funds from or through a person who distributes an intimate image in exchange for permitting the person to distribute, store, or cache an <u>intimate image.</u>
