

**1st Sub. S.B. 232**  
**SCHOOL SAFETY TIP LINE**

Senator **Daniel W. Thatcher** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:*

13           {~~→ designates the abbreviated dialing code "311" as a statewide School Safety Tip Line~~  
14    ~~subject to certain exceptions;~~}

2. *Page 2, Lines 43 through 55:*

43           As used in this part {~~→~~  
44    ~~—— (1) "311" means the abbreviated dialing code assigned by the Federal Communications~~

89           (ii) estimate the cost of operating a School Safety Tip Line including the extent to  
90    which operations will be funded through private donations and grants {~~→~~} ~~; and~~  
          (iii) designate a phone number for the School Safety Tip Line.
