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28	Location requirements.
29	[(1) As used in this section, "rules of order and procedure" means a set of rules that
30	govern and prescribe in a public meeting:
31	[(a) parliamentary order and procedure;]
32	[(b) ethical behavior; and]
33	[(c) civil discourse.]
34	(1) As used in this section:
35	(a) "Disaster" means an event that:
36	(i) causes, or threatens to cause, loss of life, human suffering, public or private property
37	damage, or economic or social disruption resulting from attack, internal disturbance, natural
38	phenomenon, or technological hazard; and
39	(ii) requires resources that are beyond the scope of local agencies in routine responses
40	to emergencies and accidents and may be of a magnitude or involve unusual circumstances that
41	require a response by a governmental, not-for-profit, or private entity.
42	(b) "Local emergency" means a condition in any municipality or county of the state,
43	which requires that emergency assistance be provided by the affected municipality or county or
14	another political subdivision to save lives and protect property within its jurisdiction in
45	response to a disaster, or to avoid or reduce the threat of a disaster.
46	(c) "Rules of order and procedure" means a set of rules that governs and prescribes in a
1 7	public meeting:
48	(i) parliamentary order and procedure;
19	(ii) ethical behavior; and
50	(iii) civil discourse.
51	(2) Subject to Subsection (3), a local school board shall:
52	(a) adopt rules of order and procedure to govern a public meeting of the local school

54	(b) conduct a public meeting in accordance with the rules of order and procedure

56	(c) make the rules of order and procedure described in Subsection (2)(a) available to

58	(i) at each public meeting of the local school board; and

60	(3) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), a local school board may not hold a
61	public meeting outside of the geographic boundary of the local school board's school district.
62	(b) A local school board may hold a public meeting outside of the geographic boundary
63	of the local school board's school district if it is necessary for the local school board to hold a
64	meeting during a disaster or local emergency.
65	[(3) Subjection (2)(a) does] (4) The requirements of this section do not affect a local
66	school board's duty to comply with Title 52, Chapter 4, Open and Public Meetings Act.
