This bill modifies the Motor Vehicles code relating to license plates.

► requires that a license plate be displayed in a manner to be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **41-1a-403** is amended to read:

**41-1a-403. Plates to be legible from 100 feet.**

License plates and the required letters and numerals on them, except the decals and the slogan, shall be of sufficient size and displayed in a manner to be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.
