30	(1) (a) As used in this section, "historic trail" means a roadway, path, or trail in the
31	state that pioneers followed while immigrating to the Salt Lake Valley and other areas of the
32	state during the mid-nineteenth century.
33	(b) "Historic trail" may include a recreational trail.
34	(2) The division shall develop and maintain an inventory of historic trails within the
35	state.
36	(3) The inventory shall include:
37	(a) mapping of the historic trails;
38	(b) photos of the historic trails;
39	(c) an assessment of the historic trail ownership, condition, and current use; and
40	(d) a classification system developed by the division to identify the current condition of
41	each trail and the availability of public access to each trail.
42	(4) The division shall:
43	(a) develop plans and recommendations to develop a historic trail system throughout
44	the state that:
45	(i) provides for outdoor recreation needs;
46	(ii) facilitates access to, travel within, and enjoyment of historic places; and
47	(iii) integrates with a recreational trail network in the state; and
48	(b) coordinate the planning and development of historic trails with:
49	(i) federal land management agencies;
50	(ii) local governments;
51	(iii) private landowners; and
52	(iv) state agencies.
53	(5) (a) The division shall prepare and submit to the governor and the Legislature, by
54	September 1, 2015, a written report of the inventory prepared under this section.
55	(b) The report shall include recommendations and cost estimates to maintain the
56	inventory and to make recommended improvements to the historic trails to allow public
57	enjoyment of the trails.
