	[(1)] (2) If a parent [with legal custody or other legal guardian] of a student, or a
	secondary student, determines that the student's participation in a portion of the curriculum or
5	in an activity would require the student to affirm or deny a religious belief or right of
6	conscience, or engage or refrain from engaging in a practice forbidden or required in the

57	exercise of a religious right or right of conscience, the parent[ <del>, guardian,</del> ] or the secondary
58	student may request:
59	(a) a waiver of the requirement to participate; or
60	(b) a reasonable alternative that requires reasonably equivalent performance by the
