LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires an individual to pass the basic civics test as a condition for receiving a high school diploma or adult education secondary diploma.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ defines terms;
- ▶ requires ~~the~~ **[a] certain** ~~high~~ **[high] public** ~~school~~ **[student] students** to pass a basic civics test as a condition

for receiving a high school diploma;

- ▶ requires a student enrolled in an adult education program to pass a basic civics test as a condition for receiving an adult education secondary diploma;
- ▶ specifies the number of correct answers an individual must provide to pass a basic civics test; and
- ▶ requires the State Board of Education to make rules.

This bill provides a special effective date.
