

Senator Ralph Okerlund proposes the following substitute bill:

SURVEY MONUMENTS REPLACEMENT

2015 GENERAL SESSION

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill establishes and amends provisions relating to a state survey monument.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ defines terms;
- ▶ clarifies reporting requirements for the protection of a survey monument;
- ▶ creates the Monument Replacement and Restoration Committee and provides for the committee's membership;
- ▶ directs the committee to administer a grant program for counties to protect and rehabilitate survey monuments;
- ▶ establishes reporting requirements; and
- ▶ makes technical changes.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates in fiscal year 2016:

▶ to the Automated ~~H→~~ **[Graphic] Geographic** ~~←H~~ Reference Center, as a one-time, non-lapsing appropriation:

- from the General Fund, one-time, ~~H→~~ **[\$1,000,000] \$100,000** ~~←H~~ with intent language that the funds be used ~~H→~~ **[by the Monument Replacement and Restoration Committee]** to provide staff support and ~~←H~~

119 (b) A county to which the center has disbursed funds under Subsection (5)(a) shall:
 120 (i) deposit the funds into the county's monument preservation fund; and
 121 (ii) expend the funds, in consultation with the committee, for the maintenance and

123 Section 3. **Appropriation.**

124 Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, for
 125 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016, the following sums of money
 126 are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts
 127 previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated. These sums of money are in
 128 addition to any amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2016.

138 Section 4. **Effective date.**

139 (1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), this bill takes effect on May 12, 2015.

140 (2) Uncodified Section 3, Appropriation, takes effect on July 1, 2015.
