**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill modifies a provision relating to state surplus property.

- ▶ modifies the definition of state surplus property to exclude a firearm or ammunition.

**63A-2-101.5**, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2013, Chapter 151

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **63A-2-101.5** is amended to read:

**63A-2-101.5. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter:

(1) "Division" means the Division of Purchasing and General Services created under Section **63A-2-101**.

(2) "Federal surplus property" means surplus property of the federal government of the



28 United States.

29 (3) "Information technology equipment" means equipment that is designed to  
30 electronically manipulate, store, or transfer a form of data.

31 (4) "Inventory property" means property in the possession of the division that is  
32 available for purchase by an agency or the public.

33 (5) "Judicial district" means a geographic district established by Section 78A-1-102.

34 (6) "Person with a disability" means a person with a severe, chronic disability that:

35 (a) is attributable to a mental or physical impairment or a combination of mental and  
36 physical impairments; and

37 (b) is likely to continue indefinitely.

38 (7) "Personal handheld electronic device":

39 (a) means an electronic device that is designed for handheld use and permits the user to  
40 store or access information, the primary value of which is specific to the user of the device; and

41 (b) includes a mobile phone, pocket personal computer, personal digital assistant, or  
42 similar device.

43 (8) "Property act" means the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of  
44 1949, 40 U.S.C. Sec. 549.

45 (9) "State surplus property" means surplus property that is not:

46 (a) a vehicle; [or]

47 (b) a firearm or ammunition; or

48 [~~(b)~~] (c) federal surplus property.

49 (10) "State surplus property contractor" means the person described in Section  
50 63A-2-410 that the state contracts with to administer the state's program for the disposition of  
51 state surplus property.

52 (11) (a) "Surplus property" means property that an agency:

53 (i) intends to divest itself of; and

54 (ii) has acquired by purchase, seizure, or donation.

55 (b) "Surplus property" does not include:

56 (i) real property;

57 (ii) assets of the School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration; or

58 (iii) an aluminum can or an item made primarily of paper, plastic, or cardboard that is:

59 (A) discarded; and

60 (B) recyclable.
