The Transportation Committee recommends **H.B. 63, DISTRACTED DRIVER AMENDMENTS**, by Representative J. Anderegg, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 63, DISTRACTED DRIVER AMENDMENTS** with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 35:*

(1) As used in this section, "hands-free talking and listening features":
(a) means technology that enables the use of a wireless telephone or other electronic device without use of either hand by employing an internal feature of, or an attachment to, the device; and
(b) includes technology that requires the use of either hand to activate, deactivate, or initiate a function of the wireless telephone or other electronic device.
